Zinedine Zidane

Zinedine Zidane was a very famous footballer. He was born in Marseille in France. His parents had moved to France from Algeria.

When he was 14, Zidane, or 'Zizou' as he was nicknamed, joined his first football club, AS Cannes. At the age of 20, he moved to Bordeaux Football Club. He was very successful there. In 1996, he joined Juventus, one of the biggest football clubs in Italy. He won two championships with Juventus. In 2001, he moved to Real Madrid, one of the greatest football clubs in Spain. Real Madrid paid 66 million dollars to Juventus for Zidane to play for them. This made him the world's most expensive player at the time.

Zidane became a national hero in France during the 1998 football World Cup. He scored twice in the World Cup final against Brazil. France won the game 3-0 and became world champion for the first time in its history.

Zidane won the Ballon D'or – one of the most important awards in world football – three times. He stopped playing football in 2006. He then became a very successful football coach.

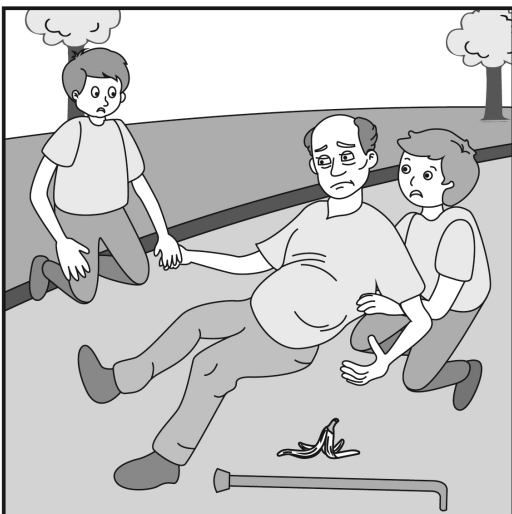
