Pre-requirements


- Tablets supplied & commissioned in Phase-III, IV & V only, which comes with pre-installed “EDLP” CMS application.
- Stable Internet Connection.
- Portable Storage Device
- USB cable

Updation Process

Stage 1: Uninstallation of the Existing EDLP APK Application


Step 1: Sync Data from the Existing Application

- Locate and open the existing “EDLP” CMS application on your device. (*refer to pic-1*)




Pic-1: Existing EDLP APK Application Icon

- Connect your device to a stable internet connection. Log in using the current user credentials. (refer to pic-2)
(NOTE: These credentials are the ones which are being used till date.)




Pic-2: Login page of existing application

- From the profile dropdown, tap "**Sync App**" to synchronize the last available offline data. (refer to pic-3 & 4)




Pic-3: Data Sync Screens-1





Step 2: Uninstall the Existing Application

- Once the data synchronization is complete, return to the home screen.
- Long-press the EDLP application icon and tap **"App Info"**.
- Tap **"Uninstall"**, then confirm the action. (refer to pic-5, 6 & 7)




Pic-5: Uninstallation Process-1

- Confirm to Uninstall the application.





Stage 2: Installation of the New EDLP APK Application


Download the New APK Application

S.No	Downloading Process
1	Download the APK file from the EDLP Training website to the EDLP Laptop using the provided link.Latest APK Version (Grade 4 to Grade 6)
2	Copy the downloaded APK file to a portable storage device (e.g., USB drive or external hard drive)
3	Connect the portable storage device to the tablet to transfer and install the APK. (OR)
4	Connect the Laptop and Tablet with the USB cable to transfer the downloaded APK to tablet



Pic-8: Latest APK Version




Pic-9: Download Form


Step 3: Install the New EDLP APK Application

- Download the updated APK file: **“edlp-prod-5.apk”** as mentioned in the above Table -1
- Tap on the downloaded file to initiate the installation.
- Allow installation from unknown sources if prompted. (refer to pic-11 & 12)

- Confirmation of Application Installed as shown in the below Pics




Pic-12: Installation Confirmation-2

Step 4: Grant Permissions and Login as Service User


- Open the newly installed EDLP application.

- Tap **"Allow"** when prompted to grant media and file access. *(refer to pic-13)*



Pic-13: Permissions Prompt


- Proceed to the login screen.




Pic-15: Service User Login

Step 5: Select Import Method


- Upon first login, a screen will appear showing options to Auto-Assign Student User and Import Content.
- Choose **“Import from Storage”**. *(refer to pic-16)*

Step 6: Select Files for Import

- Tap **“Select Files”** to browse internal storage. *(refer to pic-17)*




Pic-17: Storage Access

- Locate the “Erudex folder”. (refer to pic-18 & 19)




Pic-18: Folder Navigation-1




Pic-19: Folder Navigation-2

- Select all files in the folder by clicking on “Select all”, then tap “Select” as (refer to pic-20 & 21)




Pic-20: File Selection-1

- After selecting the files, tap **“Copy Files”** to initiate the import. (refer to pic-22 & 23)




Pic-22: No.of File Selection-2




Pic-23: Copying Files

Pic-24: Copying in Progress


- Upon completion, a success message will confirm the files were copied. ([refer to pic-25](#))



Pic-25: Copying Success


Step 8: Login as Student User

Pic-26: Back Navigation


- Enter the assigned student credentials and log in.



Pic-27: Student Login Page


- Once logged in, the main application screen will load.
- After logging in, verify that books and data are accessible in both **online and offline modes**.

- Confirm that the application syncs data correctly and displays the latest updates.




Pic-28: Application Home Screen

- Click **Download Content** in the profile menu to update and verify copied books, regardless of the student. ([refer to pic-29](#))




Pic-29: Download Content

Important Notes

- **Uninstallation Requirement:**

It is mandatory to uninstall the older version of the EDLP CMS application from all Student Tablets supplied under Phase-III, Phase-IV, and Phase-V deployments before installing the new version.

- **Compatibility of User Credentials:**

The newly issued user credentials for the Academic Year 2025 are compatible **only with the updated EDLP CMS application (Version 2.0.0)**. This applies to both the **WPF application (for Educators)** and the **APK version (for Students)**.

- **Usage Recommendation for Students:**

Students are strongly advised to use only the **APK application (EDLP CMS Version 2.0.0)** on their designated school Tablets for all academic activities.

- **Student Access to Teacher Content:**

For students to view assessments, interact with additional content, or receive assignments from teachers, it is essential that their tablets are updated with the **latest APK version (EDLP CMS 2.0.0)**.

- **WPF Upgrade Instructions for Educator Laptops:**

To upgrade the WPF on Educator Laptops provided under Phase-III, Phase-IV, and Phase-V, please refer to the detailed **User Manual and Installation Files** available on the official **EDLP Training Website**.

- **Verification of Copied Content:**

After copying the “Erudex” folder to the new directory, please verify that the correct number of books have been successfully copied for each grade level:

- Grade 4: 153 Books
- Grade 5: 100 Books
- Grade 6: 49 Books (42 Books + 7 Books (As per the content update released on 27 May 2025))
