(Version – 2.0.0)

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Pre-requirements


- Laptop supplied & commissioned in Phase-III, IV & V only, which comes with pre-installed “**EDLP**” WPF application.
- Stable Internet Connection

Updation Process

Stage 1: Uninstallation of the Existing EDLP Application

Step 1: Launch the Existing EDLP WPF Application


- Power ON the laptop.
- Locate the existing “**EDLP**” **CMS WPF Application** icon either on the Desktop or through the Start menu. *(refer to pic-1)*
- Double-click the icon to launch the application.

Step 2: Sync Offline Data


- Ensure the laptop is connected to a stable internet connection.
- Within the application, click the “**Sync Offline Data**” button. *(refer to pic-2)*
- Wait until the synchronization process completes successfully.

Step 3: Uninstall the Existing Application

- Locate the EDLP WPF Application icon.
- Right-click on the application icon.
- Select “Delete” from the context menu to remove the existing installation.
(refer to pic-3)




Pic-3: Deleting the Existing Application

Stage 2: Installation of the New EDLP WPF Application


Step 4: Download and Install the New Application

Click on the link provided in the EDLP training website to download the latest WPF application installer “EDLP Setup 2.0.0.exe” (refer to pic - 4, 5 & 6)



Pic-4 : WPF Application




Pic-5 : Download Form




Pic-6 : Download

- The application will auto-install. (refer to [pic-8](#))




Pic-8: Installation in Progress

- After successful installation, the application will launch automatically. (refer to pic-9).




Pic-9: New Application Menu Bar

- Login with assigned user credentials (refer to pic-10)




Pic-10: Login Screen

Pic-11: New EDLP WPF CMS Application Interface


- A new folder named “**EDLPLMS**” will be created in the D:\ drive. (*refer to pic-12*)

Step 5: Migrate Existing Data Folder


- Navigate to the C:\ drive and locate the existing “**Erudex**” folder.
(**NOTE:** This folder contains the book files associated with the EDLP CMS application previously installed on the laptop.) (refer to pic-13)

- Copy the “**Erudex**” folder and paste it into the newly created directory: D:\EDLPLMS.
(**NOTE / IMPORTANT:** Ensure the entire “Erudex” folder is copied without any modification. This step is mandatory to retain access to previously available book


content in the newly installed version of the EDLP CMS application.) (refer to pic-14)

Step 6: Login and Verify Functionality

- Login to the new “EDLP CMS” WPF Application. (refer to pic-15 & 16)




Pic-15: Login Screen-1

- Enter the assigned teacher login credentials on the login screen.

- After logging in, verify that books and data are accessible in both **online and offline modes**.
- Confirm that the application syncs data correctly and displays the latest updates.

Important Notes

- **Uninstallation Requirement:**

It is mandatory to uninstall the older version of the EDLP CMS application from Educator Windows laptops supplied under Phase-III, Phase-IV, and Phase-V deployments before installing the new version.

- **Compatibility of User Credentials:**

The newly issued user credentials for the Academic Year 2025 are compatible **only with the updated EDLP CMS application (Version 2.0.0)**. This applies to both the **WPF application (for Educators)** and the **APK version (for Students)**.

- **Usage Recommendation for Educators:**

Educators are strongly advised to use only the **WPF application (EDLP CMS Version 2.0.0)** on their designated school Laptops for all teaching and academic activities.

- **Student Access to Teacher Content:**

For students to view assessments, interact with additional content, or receive assignments from teachers, it is essential that their tablets are updated with the **latest APK version (EDLP CMS 2.0.0)**.

- **APK Upgrade Instructions for Student Tablets:**

To upgrade the APK on student tablets provided under Phase-III, Phase-IV, and Phase-V, please refer to the detailed **User Manual and Installation Files** available on the official **EDLP Training Website**.

- **Access for Teachers Outside School Hours:**

Teachers who wish to create assessments, upload multiple-choice questions (MCQs), or review student submissions using personal laptops outside school hours should log in using the following URL only:
